You must submit 8 (*electronically or original copies only*) clear, sharp, color photographs that best portray your project. Photographs should describe the project from start to finish, be action oriented, and include people. The work program for the project and the completed project entry form with pictures **must be submitted by May 2, 2006.**

STAR project nominations will be evaluated in Topeka by a review team. Please describe your project thoroughly because the evaluators often are not familiar with your community or situation. Recipients of the STAR Award will be announced during the 2006 PRIDE Day recognition banquet. Each award winning community recipient will receive a trophy plus a cash award. Cash amounts will be established based on number of recipients.
